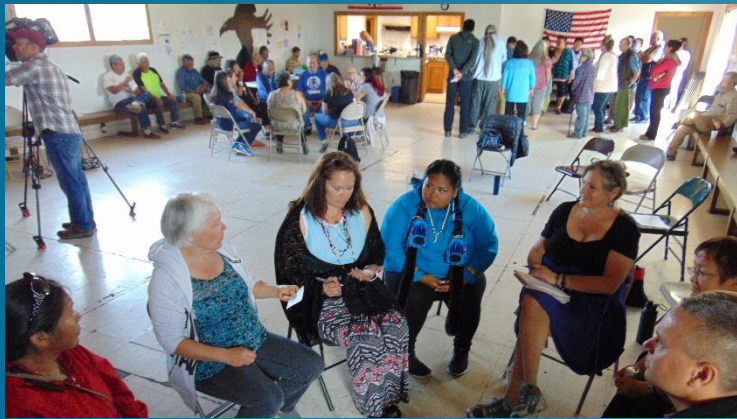
- Restore Balance
