

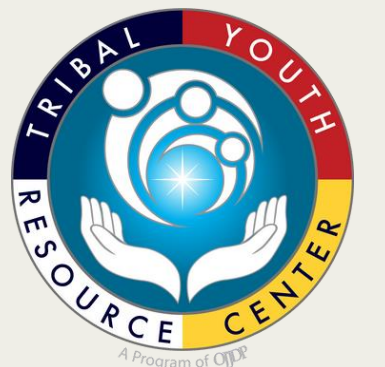

Strong or Positive Working Relationships



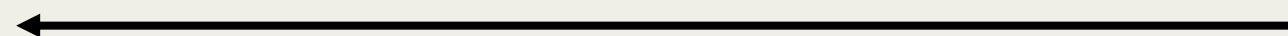
Weak or Tenuous Working Relationship



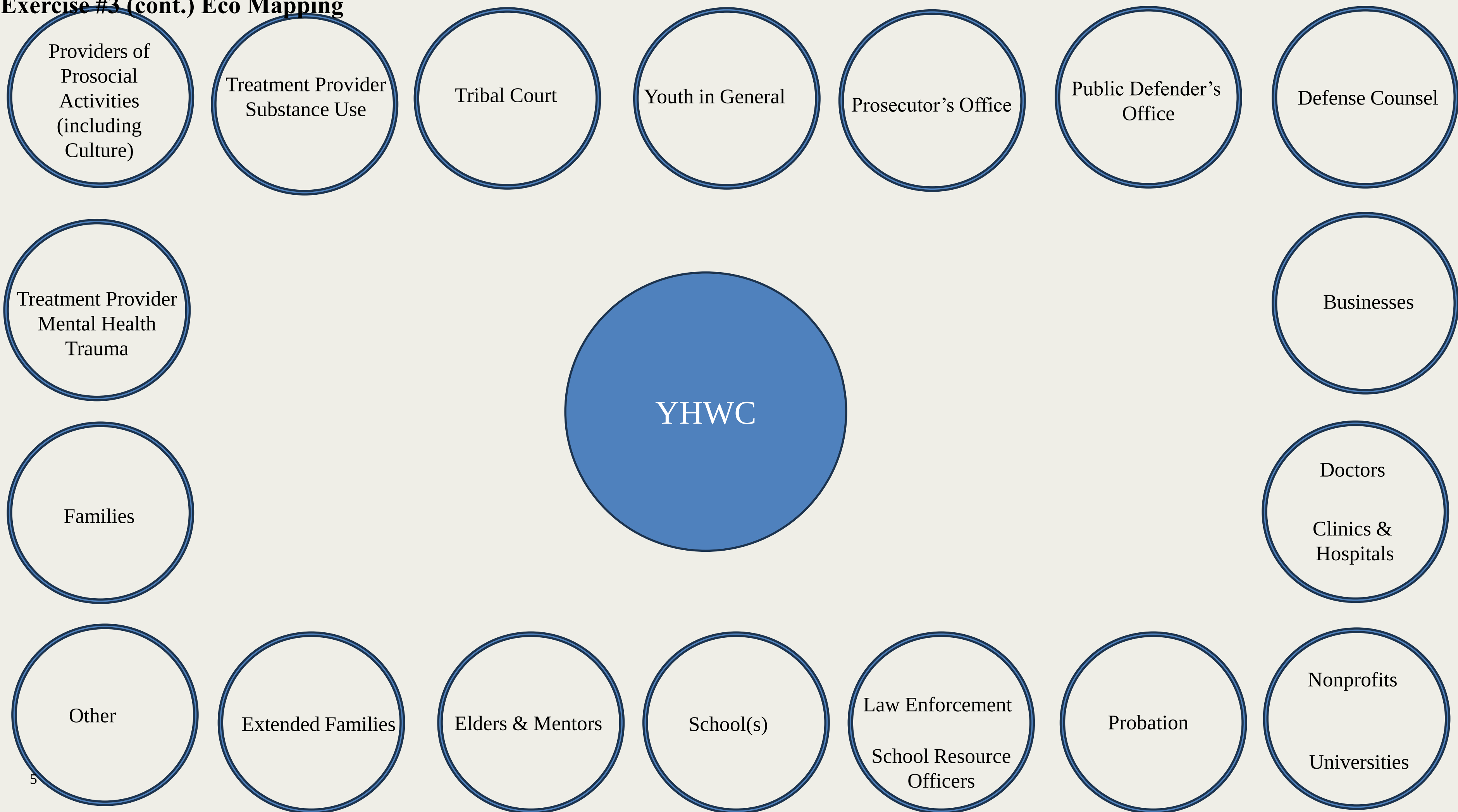
Poorly Defined Relationships
