# Roles & Responsibilities of Your Tribal Youth Planning Team & Advisory Circle/Committee

**What are the primary roles and responsibilities of the Tribal Youth Community Planning Circle/Committee members?**

- Model and commit to being an impartial and objective group in support of the TY coordinator and the Indigenous youth and their families that will be served by the program.
- Willing to contribute to the development of the overarching framework/program design from planning to sustainability.
- Willing to work together to develop necessary infrastructural supports for the planning and operational components of the planning grant.
- Knowledgeable about the youth programs in the community, trends in the community affecting the field of services, and a focused commitment to the long-range issues that impact Indigenous youth and their families.
- Commitment to contribute to developing asset-based solutions to the issues Indigenous youth face.
- Willing to build relationships and work together as a Tribal Youth Community Circle/Committee to accomplish the goals and objectives of the Cultivating Change TYP program.
- Attend monthly Tribal Youth Community Circle/Committee meetings
